GARBAGE AND TRASH REMINDER

Help Keep Your Town Beautiful

Residents are reminded that household garbage or trash is not supposed to be brought out to the curb. Household garbage should be bagged and placed inside your 95 gallon containers. The containers must not be overfilled and the lids should be kept closed.



However, with our program, garbage and ordinary trash items are to be co-mingled. Small amounts of yard trimmings, boxes, lamp shades, etc., are to be placed in your containers. **Please do not place trash out at curbside for collection.** If you place your trash at the curb, you are risking being assessed a fee for violating the Town's ordinance. ***Paid gardeners, lawn maintenance companies, or people who come to cut your grass, are required to take the yard debris away,*** not leave it for the Town to collect. Remember that the Town will not pick-up construction debris.

Bulk Trash items such as furniture, large accumulation of boxes, white goods (home appliances as refrigerators, stove, washer/dryer, dishwashers, etc.) or other large items are allowed to be place on the curbside on Wednesday for Thursday's bulk pick-up. Garbage & Trash Pick-up Days

CONDOS & APTS. (EAST ISLAND) - MON / WED / FRI
HOUSES (WEST ISLAND) - TUES / THURS / SAT

Do not place garbage containers or bags at curbside.

Place boxes and unwanted small household items in your 95 gallon containers. Trash will not be picked-up at the curb.

Recycling Pick-up Days:

CONDOS & APTS. (EAST ISLAND) - MON / THURS
HOUSES (WEST ISLAND) - TUES / FRI

Bulk Trash Pick-up Day:

THURSDAY IS THE **ONLY** DAY THAT LARGE ITEMS ARE PICKED-UP FROM CURBSIDE
(NO CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS)

Do not place large items or a large accumulation of items at curbside prior to Wednesday, in order to avoid a code violation and a possible fine.

RECYCLING

All recycling materials are now co-mingled!

NEWSPAPERS

Office Paper, Brown Paper Bags, Newspaper, Magazines, and Junk Mail

Please: Clean and dry, remove the plastic bag!

Don't: Plastic bags.

CARDBOARD

Cardboard and Paperboard

Please: Flatten. Place in or next to bin.

Don't: Foam peanuts, bubble wrap or packing paper.

PHONE BOOKS

Phone books are collected from August through November only.

Please: Place books on top of your newspapers. Discard the plastic delivery bag.

Don't: No plastic bags. Place out during collection time, only.

CANS

Aluminum and tin (steel) food & beverage cans.

Please: Clean and dry. Labels are ok.

Don't: Foil, pie tins, paint or aerosol cans, chemical containers, needles or hangers.

PLASTIC

Containers w/ a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 7 on the bottom. Examples - Juice, milk, water, dishwashing soap, and laundry detergent bottles. Yogurt, cottage cheese, & sour cream tubs.

Please: Clean & dry. Look for the number on the bottom.

Don't: Plastic bags, chemical or foam containers, medical waste, IV bags or tubing or hangers.

GLASS

Clear, brown & green glass food & beverage containers, such as: soda, juice, wine, baby food, ketchup & salad dressing.

Please: Clean and dry, remove and discard caps & lids.

Don't: Window glass, drinking glasses, ceramic glass, mirrors, light bulbs, or ovenware.

DRINK BOXES

Milk & juice cartons, drink boxes & "gable top" type cartons, such as those used to package fabric softener.

Please: Clean & dry. Remove and discard caps and straws.

Don't: Straws or caps.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES & TONER CARTRIDGES: Instead of throwing away your household batteries and toner cartridges with your regular trash, please bring them to Town Hall so they can be properly recycled.



THANK YOU FOR RECYCLING!

Remember, no pharmaceutical or pesticide containers. Place recyclable paper items in the bottom of your bin so they don't blow away. If it's raining, save your papers until your next recycling day.
