A Message from the Mayor

Picnic and Paddleboards – Spring Must be in the Air

In Bay Harbor Islands springtime is in full swing with residents circling March 22nd on their calendars for our annual Anita and Morris Broad Community Picnic and Earth Day Celebration. It's a great opportunity to spend time outdoors, relax with your neighbors and salute this beautiful place we are so fortunate to call home. Be sure to check out the paddleboarding before the picnic, even if just to watch! It's such a great addition to our annual get together.

In mid-March, everyone will begin receiving invitations to complete the 2020 Census. The U.S. Census Bureau only does this once every 10 years so it is very important that we get this right to ensure our Town is properly counted. Taking the census is confidential, safe and easy and only takes about 10 minutes but the results will help determine how hundreds of billions of dollars in federal funding flow into our communities every year for the next decade!

If you are filling out the census for your home, count everyone who is living there as of April 1, 2020. This includes any friends or family members who are living and sleeping there most of the time. If someone is staying in your home on April 1, and has no usual home elsewhere, you should count them. And don't forget the children who are living with you. Count foster children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews, and the children of friends, even if they are living with you temporarily. Please also be sure to count roommates, young children and newborns who are still in the hospital.

Finally, just a reminder – don't forget to Spring forward! Daylight saving time begins on Sunday, March 8, 2020.

ANNUAL TOWN COUNCIL ELECTION - UPDATE

Two seats up for vote on April 7th

The Town of Bay Harbor Islands will hold its annual municipal election Tuesday, April 7th, to fill two seats on the Town Council. As of the writing of this Newsletter, Council Members Joshua Fuller and Elizabeth Tricoche have announced their candidacy to seek re-election.

All residents who are registered voters are urged to come to Town Hall on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. to cast votes to fill the open seats. Under state law, the books close to new registrations 29 days prior to the election (March 9th). If you haven't registered to vote, changed your address or have any questions about your registration, please contact the Miami-Dade County Elections Department at 305-499-8683. To check on the status of your registration or to register on-line go to: <http://www.miamidade.gov/elections/voter-registration.asp>

The Town's two precincts are combined in one location for our municipal election. The polling place is located in the Council Chambers on the second floor of Town Hall at 9665 Bay Harbor Terrace. Remember to bring your voter's card and official photo identification with your name, address and signature (such as a driver's license).

If you wish to become a candidate for a Town Council seat, file with the Town Clerk during regular business hours at Town Hall after 9 a.m. on Thursday, February 27th and before 5 p.m. on Friday, March 6th. To qualify you must be a registered voter and have been a Bay Harbor resident for at least 12 months. 
Get Ready to Paddle!




